

Policy Statement for Health and Safety at Work

The WESTFLEISCH Group's policy statement for health and safety at work addresses all employees and sections of the company. It defines the corporate responsibility of the enterprise as well as the subsequent key aspects for realisation of the subject area „health and safety at work“. Objective of the WESTFLEISCH safety at work management system is keeping the health of the employees and the continuous improvement of health and safety conditions in the workplace.

Safety at work is task of the Executive Board, Seniors and Employees.

All persons collaborate likewise responsible for the daily implementation of work safety measures. Everyone has the duty to indicate recognised hazards and the right to eliminate risk potentials.

Laws and regulations

WESTFLEISCH commits to adhere to relevant laws and regulations. Cooperation with authorities, institutions and qualified partners are permanently cultivated. The works committee is involved in planning and realisation of health and safety measures.

Health and Safety in the Workplace

It is a firm part of the work safety management system to arrange the organisation and the facilities such way that health and safety of the employees is not harmed. Analysis on hazards and stress are affected hereto. Preventive measures have priority.

Information and training

The group trains all employees regularly and sensitises in order to reliable conduct at their workplace. It provides the opportunity of individual training dealing with „health and safety at work“. All employees have the responsibility and duty to attend this offer and transfer the knowledge gained in their work process.

Investments

The work safety equipment required by the management system will be planned site-specific and provided in agreement with the Executive Board.

Verification of effectiveness

The effectiveness of the decisions made is checked on a regular basis. To ensure that this work safety policy statement is implemented and the defined goals are achieved, internal and external audits as well as the assessment and analysis of objective key figures from external inspections will be applied. Improvement potentials are investigated and appropriate measures taken.
