

African Swine Fever **ASF – imminent danger**

ASF is a highly contagious, febrile disease of pigs with an epidemic course. It is primarily spread transmitted by pigs (wild boar, domestic pigs) and by people and vehicles. traffic. It is almost always fatal for infected animals.



There is **no risk of infection** for human beings. Even the consumption of meat products from infected animals is **safe** for humans.

SPECIFIC DANGERS OF INTRODUCTION:

- Items, which have been in contact with wild boar (Clothing, boots/ shoes, weapons etc.)
- Parts of pigs (skins, hunting trophies etc.)
- Living pigs
- Foods containing pork
